

HARBOR HILLS COUNTRY CLUB REGULATIONS

We appreciate your patronage! That staff at HHCC are committed to extending all members, guests, and visitors' an enjoyable experience and a safe environment while visiting Harbor Hills Country Club. We ask that you observe the following regulations.

Clubhouse:

- The staff reserves the right to refuse anyone from being served alcoholic beverages.
- All members, guests and visitors are expected to follow the "Code of Conduct". Proper conduct and language is expected at all times.
- Under no circumstance will alcoholic beverages be allowed on the course or in the Clubhouse, unless purchased from HHCC.

Golf Course:

ALL MEMBERS AND GUESTS MUST SIGN IN AT THE FRONT DESK OF THE CLUBHOUSE.

- Observe all rules and etiquette as instructed on the HHCC Scorecard.
- Observe all rules for personally owed and Club rented golf carts.
- Proper golf attire is required.
- All alcoholic beverages, other than purchased from HHCC are prohibited. All alcoholic beverages must stay within the white stakes known as "Out of Bounds"
- Keep all carts 30 yards from the greens and at least 10 yards for the tees and bunkers.
- Always maintain pace of play. All players are expected to keep pace with the group in front of them.
- Golfers are responsible for any damages to the Club owed carts, golf course and private property adjacent to the golf course.
- Repair all divots and ball marks.
- Golfers are prohibited from trespassing on private property adjacent to the course (members included).
- Club owed carts must not leave HHCC property.
- No more than 2 bags and 2 persons are permitted on the cart. Absolutely no one is permitted to ride on the back of a cart.
- Each player must have a set of clubs.
- Fivesome are allowed with permission from the staff. Players must allow faster players and or smaller groups to play through.
- No person under the age of 16 years of age and without a proper Driver's License may rent or drive a personally owed cart.
- Motorized carts may be required during certain times, as determined by management.
- Proper golfing footwear is required while on the golf course.
- All children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

Violation of any of these regulations may result in a request to leave the premises without a refund. Or, in the case of a member, action such as suspension or revocation of their membership with no refund may be taken.
